## The israelo-Palestinian conflict

Since 1948, people have been suffering and dying from war in Palestine.

The 1948 has two meanings: for Israel it is the birth of the state of Israel, to the Palestinians it is the year of the Nakba which means “catastrophe”.

Palestinians were taken away from their homes and many became refugees in the adjoining countries: Jordan, Egypt and Lebanon. Many Palestinians have fought for their land in recent years and have been killed. The resistance (Al Mukawama) of the Palestinians is famous throughout the world. On the 7th of October 2023, Hamas attacked Israel. After this attack, Israel started an ongoing conflict. It is important to acknowledge that the years before the events that took place in October 2023 were characterized by unprecedented violence, creating a scenario not very different from a war scenario.



Only in 2023, five heavy military attacks took place in Jenin, as well as numerous others in the rest of the West Bank, in particular in the area of Nablus, East Jerusalem and Gaza, bringing further devastation and death to territories already seriously compromised. Today, 4 months after the beginning of the conflict, at least 27,947 Palestinians have died and at least 67,459 have been wounded. The crisis seems to be very far from a resolution and people continue to suffer and die.
